


BRIDGE CENTER FACILITY HIGHLIGHTS

In the second quarter of 2022, the Bridge Center for Hope continued to raise awareness and educate the community. The Bridge Center hosted its 2nd Annual Bridging the Gap Community Fair, participated in various community presentations, and served as a resource vendor for multiple community events.

In the second quarter, the guest presentations to the facility were 806, with 782 admitted. Six hundred and fifty-six were unduplicated guests with an average 16% quarterly readmission rate. (Guests are considered readmitted if served within 30 days or less after discharge.)


During the second quarter, there were 592 direct-entry (walk-ins) and 190 accompanied by first responders. Details on first responders (local law enforcement and EMS) are provided in the table below. The average response time for first responders was 3.02 minutes.



QUARTERLY REPORT

Demographics

Among the guest during the second quarter, 71% were males, and 29% were females. Three hundred and seventy-three received mental health services, while three hundred and sixty-nine received substance use services, and forty were unreported or unknown.
